Parents Survey 2024

Over 95% of parents/carers are reporting their children are happy at Bird in Bush School and they are happy with the education their children receive and the way in which if they do have any concerns that the school responds appropriately and in a timely manner to support their child. This is an exceptional recommendation for the school and a position to build on.

Strengths noted at the school include: the after school provision; the way any concerns with bullying are dealt with; encouraging positive behaviour; the reading and writing improvements; the school's leadership, teachers and staff and the way they manage the children.

Requested areas for improvement include considering different ways to communicate with parents/carers; more financial support/ vouchers where possible as well as both sides of the homework issue.

How we're encouraging children at our school to read for pleasure






"Developing staff knowledge of children's literature"
